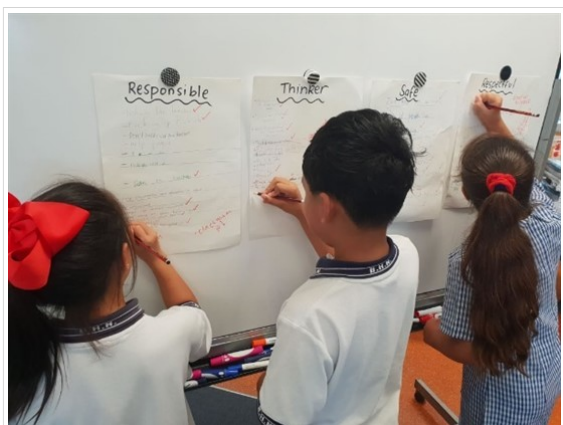
## LEARNING AT BHN
