## No Parking Zone in Shorter Ave

To help all parents understand the road rules and avoid conflicting messages. The NSW road rules state:



- You must not stop for more than two minutes in a No Parking area.
- You must remain in or within 3 metres of the vehicle.
- Mobility Parking Permit holders are allowed to park for up to 5 minutes in a No Parking area.

Hours of operations may apply to some signs. This means restrictions apply for those times only.

The hours of operation for our Shorter Ave no parking zone are 8:30-9:30am and 3:00-4:00pm.

3/4M are writing a persuasive text about 'Saving insects from extinction'. After planning their point of view and arguments, students jointly wrote a draft introduction.








### 5/6B


# **P&C NEWS**
