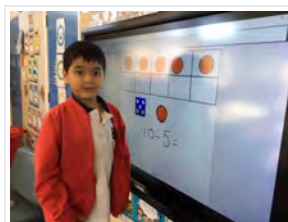

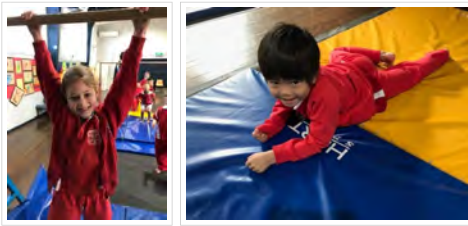
KY

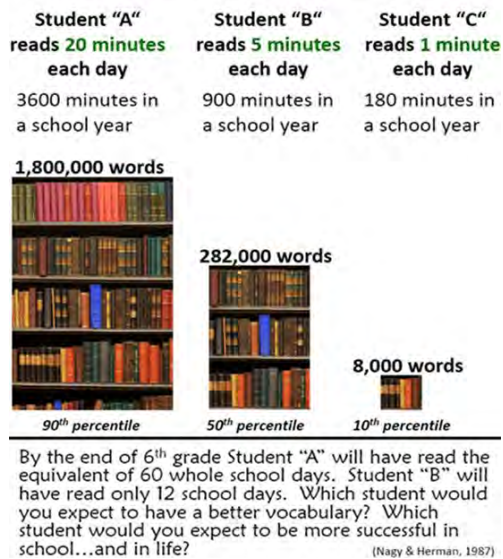
