The artwork looks nice but also has a deeper level to it. So the circular sections in this work are based loosely off meeting places. Traditionally a meeting place would have been a camp site where people would have come together to share, learn and pass on knowledge. In our communities Schools are a perfect example of a modern day meeting place bringing people together for education. I have overlapped these within the artwork to symbolise different years, groups and classes all working together as one making up the school community All working in harmony. Throughout this artwork I have used two different sized dots, the smaller being for the students and the larger representing the teachers and staff who are full of knowledge.

LEARNING AT BHN

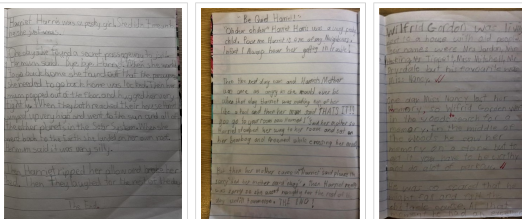
KR

5/6P

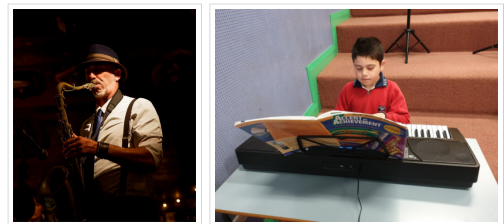
5/6P are learning and playing board games once a week for half an hour.

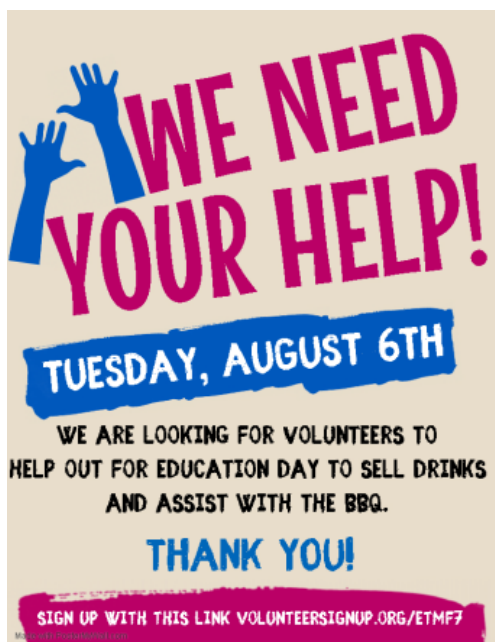
