Attendance

Every Day Counts

As we begin our new year, we remind parents/guardians of the importance of school attendance. A lot of research exists which highlights the link between attendance and success in the classroom. Most students attend school each day. Every day at school counts. Missing even one day can make a difference over time. If a student misses 1 day of school each fortnight, it adds up to missing more than a year of learning over 12 years, one day a week is equivalent to missing over 2.5 years of school and so on as shown in the table below.

With this in mind, we ask parents/guardians to have your child at school punctually by 8.55am. If your child is absent on any given day, please call the school on 97593849 by 9.00am to inform us of the absence and its nature. A note from a parent/ guardian is to be presented to your child's classroom teacher on your child's return to school.
