## Looking Ahead to Term 2

### Canteen Tender

I am currently in the process of running a tender to find a new operator to run the canteen. Unfortunately, Donna from Donna's Delights will be ending her contract on May 17<sup>th</sup> with the anticipated start date of the new licensee being May 29<sup>th</sup>. This will mean that the school will not have a functioning canteen for a week.

### Playground and Roofing Upgrades

Work will be commencing next week, Monday April 3<sup>rd</sup> on the upgrade and resurfacing of the playground space outside the library extending down to the sandpit and past the student toilets. Synthetic turf will be laid around the sandpit and the playground will be resurfaced with asphalt during the holidays. We are hoping to have the sandpit operational at some point next term and add additional markings to the playground spaces for students to enjoy during recess and lunch. The Year 2 rooms and 5/6B classroom will have their roof replaced with Colourbond roofing during Term 2.

### Parent Workshops

We will be commencing workshops for parents in Term 2. These workshops will be aimed at upskilling parents with the

learning and skills happening in classrooms. This will enable parents to better assist students so there is consistency in learning between school and home. We will also hold workshops to inform parents of external agencies that can support in the following areas:

- NDIS
- Preschools in the area
- Local library and services
- Occupational and Speech therapy
- Paediatricians
- After hours educational support
- Online parent workshops (students with additional needs)

Further details will follow next term.

## Student Learning

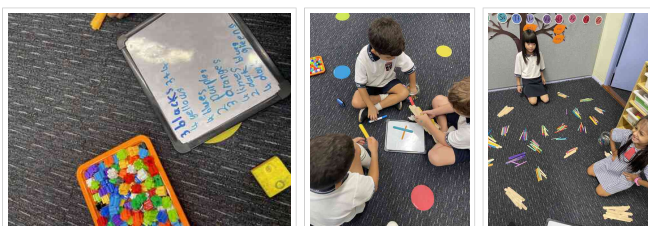
### KG

### 3/4L

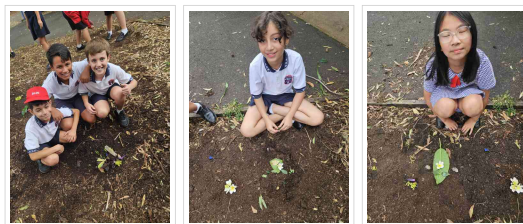
3/4L have been working on the concept of length in Mathematics. They created colourful cityscapes by combining
