Student Learning

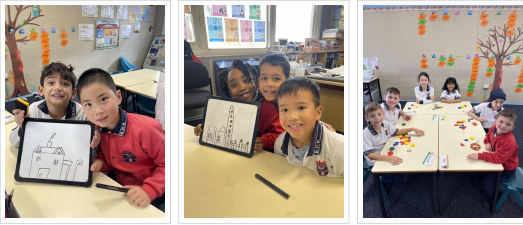
KF
